



Bonjour et bienvenue! Hello and welcome! Here is your French lesson for this week.

1. Log in to the Petite Etoile website : www.petite-etoile.co.uk
2. Go onto the Great Ouse Primary page:
 - a. Click on the 'find your school' tab at the top of the home page
 - b. Click on Great Ouse Primary
3. Scroll down to 'Your French lesson for this week.'
4. If you need any support with the different areas of vocabulary, don't forget to look at the 'lesson recap' videos to help you.

We would like you to spend **one lesson** (approximately 1 hour) completing the Mr French workbook which is designed to recap and extend the French that we have already covered before we move onto something new. You will all have started working through this in your lessons but you will all be at different stages.
